Onalaska Middle School Shatters Wisconsin Record



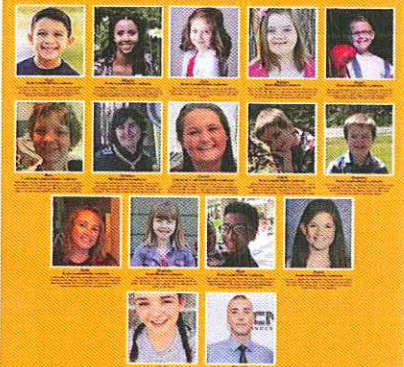
Onalaska Middle School, a long time participant in Pennies for Patients, raised **\$13,421.15 making it the top fundraising school in WI history!** During their two-week program students collected money in classrooms, took part in competitions and made online donations. Students even created their own online fundraising pages which helped the school to raise **\$3,647** online and pushed them over their \$10,000 goal! Pennies volunteer coordinator, Brian Mastin, told ABC news affiliate WXOW why he thinks the students continue to do better every year, "Really I think the most important thing is it's a really meaningful cause for them, because so many of them have experienced cancer somewhere in their lives. Either family members or friends, neighbors, or relatives so I think it is something that is dear to them."
