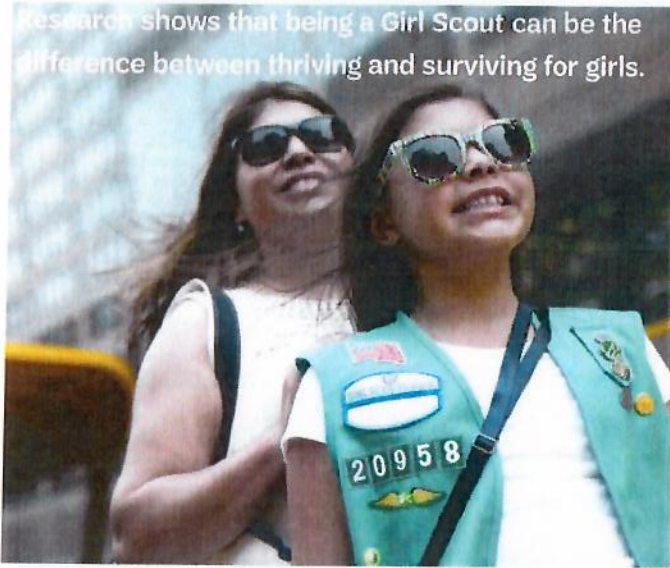


THE GIRL SCOUT DIFFERENCE
