Dear Parents and Guardians,

As a result of the current level of COVID-19 infection, the School District of Onalaska is extending virtual learning through at least **October 16**. The [District Reopening Plan](#) calls for virtual learning at all grade levels when the county exceeds 25 new daily cases per 100,000 people on a seven day average. The current rate as reported by the [La Crosse County Health Department](#) is 49 new daily cases per 100,000 people on a seven day average, indicating that the county remains in the severe range related to the spread of the virus and that it is not safe for the congregation of large groups. The new case rate is a significant decrease from last week and there is hope that we can move to in-person programming if the trend continues.

Every Wednesday the District will update our [local dashboard](#) and make a determination concerning virtual or in-person learning.

Thank you for your continued support during the beginning of this year; your efforts with your children have not gone unnoticed. Please reach out to your school administrators for any additional needs you may have in the virtual learning environment.
