Dear Parents and Guardians,

As a result of the current level of COVID-19 infection, the School District of Onalaska is extending virtual learning through at least **October 23**. The [District Reopening Plan](#) calls for virtual learning at all grade levels when the county exceeds 25 new daily cases per 100,000 people on a seven day average. The current rate as reported by the [La Crosse County Health Department](#) is 31.7 new daily cases per 100,000 people on a seven day average, indicating that the county remains in the severe range related to the spread of the virus and that it is not safe for the congregation of large groups. The new case rate continues to decrease over the past two weeks and there is hope that we can move to in-person programming if the trend continues.

Every Wednesday the District will update our [local dashboard](#) and make a determination concerning virtual or in-person learning. We understand that it can be frustrating to hear the same communication week after week. Please know it is our ultimate goal to return to in-person learning, and looking at it on a weekly basis is the best way to do that.

We appreciate your ongoing engagement, partnership, and understanding as we continue to navigate this school year together. Please reach out to your school administrators for any additional needs you may have in the virtual learning environment.
