

Application for Junior Parking Permit **School Parking Regulations**

The following rules and regulations regarding student cars are made for the protection of the student body and the public (The school does not assume responsibility or liability for damages or losses to student vehicles).

NOTICE: Due to the limited number of parking spots, permits will be issued to all interested Seniors. Juniors must apply for a chance at being drawn for a Junior Parking Permit. The number of junior parking spots fluctuates based on the number of senior permits sold.

- 1) Students driving to school will park in the school provided parking lot and in student designated areas (see map on back). Students will not park in reserved staff spaces, visitor spaces, disabled spaces, no-parking spaces or in the Senior Lot. Students shall not park in such a manner that obstructs other parking spots or the flow of traffic. Failure to comply will result in a ticket.
- 2) Parking permits may be obtained from the office at a cost of \$40.00. **This permit must be clearly displayed on the rear view mirror of the vehicle, facing out! Failure to display the permit will result in a ticket.**
- 3) There will be a \$5.00 charge to replace lost permits. Please report lost or stolen permits immediately, prior to receiving a ticket. Missing permit numbers will be reported to the police for fraudulent use in the parking lot.
- 4) Students are not to loiter in the parking lot. This includes sitting in cars.
- 5) Students will obey posted speed signs and stop signs! Failure to do this may result in a fine for negligent operation of a vehicle.
- 6) Students will report all accidents.
- 7) Students vehicles on school grounds are subject to search by school officials when there is a suspicion of alcohol, drugs, weapons, stolen materials, etc.
- 8) Permits are non-transferable. Students may not give or sell their permits to other students. If this occurs, it will result in a parking citation and a loss of the parking privileges.
- 9) **Onalaska School District reserves the right to deny or revoke parking privileges for disciplinary matters and/or attendance issues. This may carry over into students' senior year. Students who have their parking passes revoked will not have the parking fee refunded.**

PERMIT PARKING ONLY!

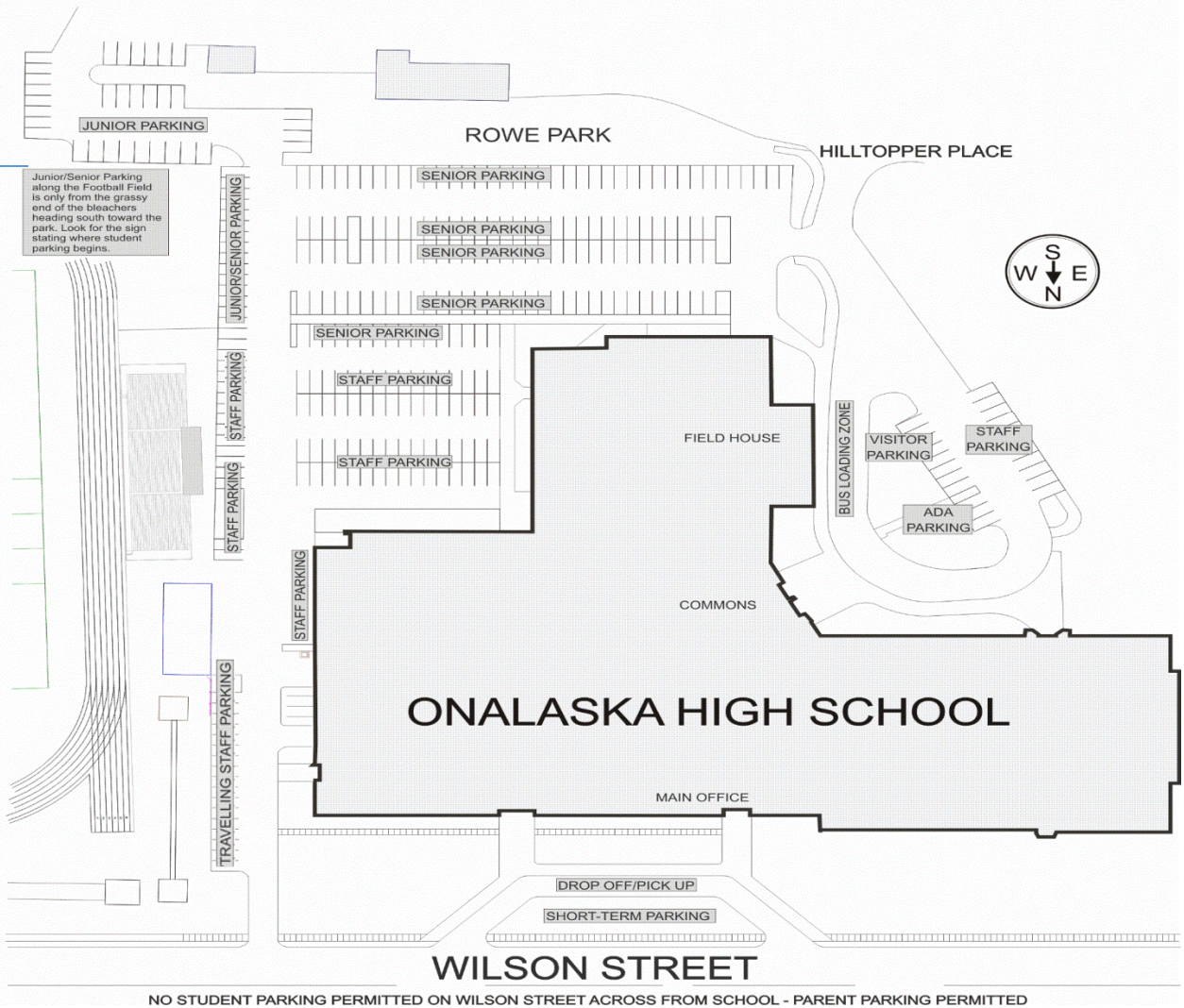

Seniors may park here when no other spaces are available in the senior lot.

Juniors who are allowed to park here will be told personally by an administrator.
